Updates from Dean Preston (7:35pm)

- Free Muni throughout the entire weekend in celebration of Lunar New Year
- Got the 31 back, but hoping to get the 22 back (as well as the 6, 41, etc)
- Recently got a commitment from MTA to get these lines back, MTA board confirmed in December 2021, Omicron decimated the staffing shortage, but most service restoration March pushed to June 2022
- Bike share still being discussed
- Bike lanes on Oak/improvements still being discussed.
- Public safety: Two people on Fillmore victims of shootings, last week and a half things are intense (in fear of retaliation, etc)
- Housing & Homelessnes:
 - 1 in 10 units is vacant, 40,000 units are vacant (some is natural vacancy), however, fastest is investors buying spaces. Residential tax vacancy may be on the ballot this year.
 - Eviction prevention: Eviction 10 day warning passed before moving forward with eviction
 - Protections for non-payment (due to Covid)
 - Working for many months to get the Gotham Hotel acquired, the mayor and HSH has moved forward. 114 unit building
- Questions:
 - Proposals for vacancy tax

Captain Pedrini (7:57pm)

- Pedrini has been for a year and a half.
- 2 rapes reported this year (up 100% 1 versus 2). Pedrini says
- Rob rate down 44% (5 versus 4)
- Burglary down 34% (higher than 2019)
- Motor vehicle theft up (50 incidents versus 30)
- Arson (3 versus 0)
- Biggest issue in the Park District is residential burglaries. Significantly changed in 2020, due to shelter in place order.
